EMERGENCY/DISASTER KITS

T&C requires that you provide an Emergency Disaster Kit for your child here at school. We ask you, with the help of your child, to produce a personal package of supplies which will be here for the school year as the provisions he or she would need in case of any disaster or extended time at school. Please use this as a learning opportunity to help your child understand the purpose of his/her EMERGENCY KIT. We will also teach about this at school. Please pack the following items in a 2-gallon Ziploc bag:

- 1-3x5 card with your child's name, address, Mom & Dad's phone #s and emergency phone #s
- 1-small towel
- 1-small Kleenex packet
- 1-small Handiwipe packet
- 1 sweatshirt or sweater
- 2 pair of underwear
- If diapers are worn at night, please pack 2 diapers
- 2-6oz. cans (no boxes) of juice
- 6-8 small, vacuum-packed snack packs *that you child likes to eat* (crackers & cheese, peanut butter, beef jerky, fruit cups, pudding) and place these in smaller baggies to keep bugs out.
- 48-hour supply of prescription medication with administration instructions, if needed
- 1-very small flashlight with batteries not installed
- A personal note from you to your child explaining that you will pick up him or her as soon as you possibly can and that teachers at T&C will care for him until then.
- A family picture

Please return these supplies in your clearly labeled 2-gallon bag when your child begins classes at Town & Country.

Emergency kits will be returned at the end of each school year so that they can be updated with clothes that fit, etc. for the following school year.

If any emergency occurs when your child is at school, Town & Country teachers and staff are prepared to stay with your child until you are able to arrive to take him or her. We will also be in communication via radio with the Palos Verdes Police and Fire Department for emergency instructions via our Ham radio system.

We appreciate your help in providing these supplies to make your child's "emergency stay" as comfortable as possible.
